Malikango Irrigation Scheme

FACT SHEET

SCHEME LOCATION

Located in ward 11 - Chiredzi District.

Approximately 8 km from Chikombedzi Business Centre and 100km from Chiredzi town

Size

The scheme is 100 hectares

It has 104 beneficiaries (31 males and 73 females), including 2 male youths

Scheme History

The scheme was established in 1965 with 100ha.

Currently, 42ha are under irrigation using diesel engine pump

Water Source

The scheme draws water from Mwenezi River, with water coming from Manyuchi Dam which is upstream.

Date of completion: 28 July 2023

Actual date of completion: 31 January 2022

Contract value: US\$ 871 150, 35

Reason for rehabilitation: Electricity transformer needed replace-

ment, Dam wall was swept away after heavy rains in 2016

Scope of works

Development of scheme to 100 hectares

Rehabilitation and construction of canals

Installation of 250mm pipeline from pump house to night storage $\,$

dam

Replacement of diesel pumping system with solar

Progress to date: 17% complete

Crop production in the scheme: Maize (summer)

Sugar beans (winter)
